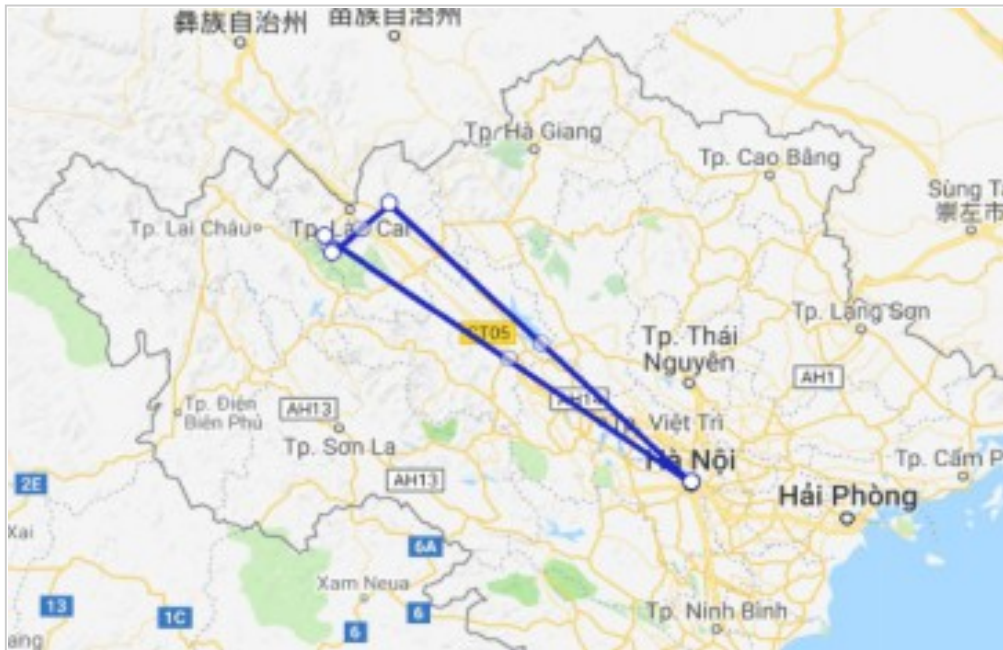

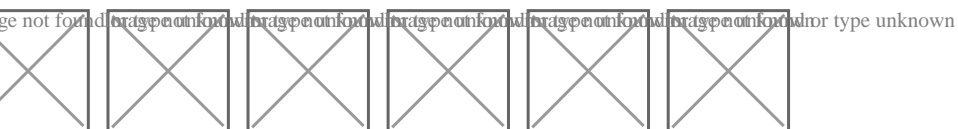

### Night 1 (Sun): Hanoi - Night train to Lao Cai

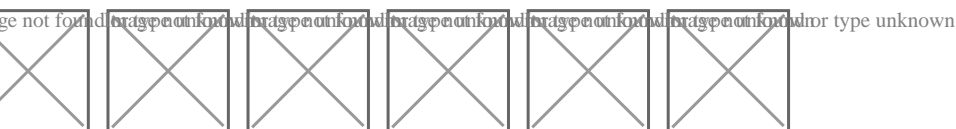
Pick up at your hotel (**20.30**) and transfer to Hanoi Railway Station to take the night train from to Lao Cai. Sleep on the train.

**09.30AM:** 6km of walking down to the south east of Sapa along the side of Muong Hoa valley to Y Linh Ho village of the Black H'mong. Continue on 2km of trekking down to Lao Chai village of the H'mong. Lunch at a local family, and then walk through terraced rice fields to Ta Van village of the Dzay minority people where we stay for the night. It gives you a worth chance for you to learn about the local house architecture which is full of their daily life styles and exclusive custom. Enjoy the landscapes...on the way. Get back to Sapa by jeep or motorbike.

## Day 2 (Tue): Sapa - Coc Ly market - Lao Cai - Night train to Hanoi

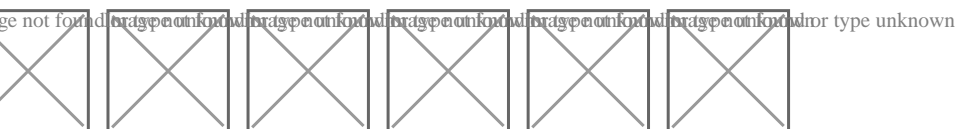

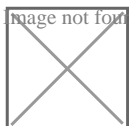
